Clean the World collects discarded soap and other hygiene products from more than 4,000 hotel and resort partners and operates recycling centres in North America, Asia, and Europe. Through its hygiene kit program, Clean the World provides personal care items to relief organizations throughout North America. Since 2009, more than 36 million bars of Clean the World soap have been distributed in 100 countries and the organization's global operation has contributed to a 30 per cent reduction in pre-adolescent deaths from hygiene-related illnesses.
